

MINUTES of a MEETING OF WHEATACRE BURGH ST. PETER
PARISH COUNCIL
HELD on 20 September 2023 at 7.30pm

1. MINUTES.

Proposed Cllr Cowin seconded Cllr Beaumont 'That the Minutes of the last meeting (16 August 2023) were taken as read and signed as a true record of the meeting.'

2. MATTERS ARISING.

a) Dicks Mount Street Sign. After the clerk sent South Norfolk Council a photograph of the existing sign they agreed to replace it with a standard street name plate. This will take between 6 to 8 weeks.

3. PLANNING

Waveney River Centre Applications ;

- a) BA/2023 / 74 Re-siting of 8 holiday lodges**
- b) BA/2023 / 75 Provision of 15 touring pitches.**
- c) BA/2023 / 76 Siting of 14 chalets & associated works.**

All the above applications have been approved by the Broads authority Planning Committee meeting on 18 August 2023.

d) 2023 / 2477 Land off White Lion Road, Wheatacre.

Retention of two containers for agricultural storage.

Councillors thought that if this application was approved that conditions should be included to screen the containers such as to allow the road side boundary hedge to grow to the height of the containers.

4. CORRESPONDENCE.

a) Burgh St. Peter village hall. The Chairperson of the Village Hall Committee asked for the Parish Council's approval to accept the quotation for redecorating the hall as she thought that the Parish Council would pay for the works. The clerk advised the Chairperson that although the parish councillors can give a donation towards works carried out on the hall by the Village Hall Committee on this occasion councillors decided not to give a donation.

b) Clerks Direct. This was circulated.

5. FINANCE.

- a) Proposed cllr Cowin seconded cllr Cowin ‘ That the clerk is paid half yearly salary and expenses .’

- a) **Parking along White Lion Road.** Customers of the White Lion are parking along both sides of White Lion Road causing a hazard to passing traffic. Clerk to write to owner and ask if additional parking could be provided at the rear of the premises.
- b) **Memorial garden for Duncan Scott.** This has been built by Saffron Housing Trust by the village cross roads to remember the services of this former Saffron tenant and Board Member.
- c) **Flat swing seat.** This has been damaged and needs inspecting and possible replacement.
